### **FOUR SDHSAA STATE GOLF MEETS TEE OFF MONDAY**

May 16, 2014

PIERRE – The South Dakota High School Activities Association’s final four Golf State Tournaments will tee off Monday at four courses across the state. This year’s competitions are scheduled as two-day, thirty-six hole events, with the ‘AA’ Girls in Pierre at Hillsvie Golf Course and the ‘A’ Girls in Spearfish at Spearfish Canyon Country Club. Class B will be split between two sites in Mitchell – Lakeview Golf Course for the Girls and Wild Oaks Golf Course for the boys. Also, new this spring, will be the incorporation “Live Scoring” results, stats and leader boards for all four tournaments available at [sports.sdpb.org](http://sports.sdpb.org).

In Class ‘AA’ competition, the field is led by the return of just three of the top ten finishers from last year including Sioux Falls Lincoln’s Abbie Grevlos. Grevlos, a senior, posted a 7<sup>th</sup> place individual finish as a sophomore and a runner-up finish in last year’s event. O’Gorman’s Kelsey Johnson, a junior, is also looking for her third consecutive finish in the top ten, having finished in 4<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> place the past two years. O’Gorman is also perhaps the favorite in the team race in this year’s event, entering with a state-best scoring average of 324, nearly twenty shots better than their nearest competitor.

The Class ‘A’ field also features three of last year’s top-ten finishers, including Freshman Sydney Bormann of Parkston. Bormann won the Class ‘A’ individual title as a 7<sup>th</sup> grader and finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in last year’s rain-shortened event. Bormann and her teammates from Parkston will also be chasing after their third consecutive Girls ‘A’ team title, which would also make a fourth such championship in six years for the Trojans.

Class ‘B’ will see new champions in each gender’s individual title race, as well as a new team champion on the girls’ side as Andes Central’s girls failed to qualify as a team. Only two of the top ten individuals on the boys’ side return, while half of the girls’ top ten is back. Garretson will look to defend its boys’ crown, while both Deuel and Deubrook Area are back to challenge for the girls title. Either Deuel or Deubrook has finished in the top two team places on the girls’ side in each of the past four years.
